## What is Adaptil®:

Adaptil can help reduce or eliminate behaviors brought on by stressful situations such as visits to the veterinarian, loud noises, travel stress and other situations that cause dogs anxiety. **It's time to take your dog to the veterinarian. Some dogs get stressed during the visit. You can make this a much more pleasant experience by following these helpful tips:**

### Before and during the veterinary visit:

1. Wipe the inside of the car where your dog will sit with an Adaptil wipe 10 minutes before leaving home. Let the alcohol evaporate before putting your dog in the car. You can wipe any type of surface without any harm to your car.
2. Wipe the leash and collar of your dog with an Adaptil wipe as well.
3. If necessary, use a treat to entice your dog to get into the car.
4. Keep small treats on hand during the entire visit as rewards and distractions.



## The return home from the veterinarian:

Reapply Adaptil to the car before leaving the hospital.
